Toilets, Taps, Bins and Buoys!!

The return of hot weather after lockdown brought many visitors to Calshot, most of whom respected the social distancing rule. Social distancing is still required, so please be aware of this when enjoying the beach. Please report any anti-social behaviour to 101, quoting the postcode, SO45 1BR.

NFDC have been working hard to reopen as many public toilets as possible and of the 23 in the district, 20 are now open. Unfortunately, because of the construction of the Calshot Slipway Toilet block and the lack of natural ventilation in the building, it must remain closed for public safety. NFDC have doubled the number of operatives who are deep cleaning the toilets twice a day and who are working 9½ hour shifts. The toilets are locked at night to ensure they are clean for the morning.



In the next 2 weeks the water taps will be re-connected with appropriate signage put in place to provide safety advice for their use.

New bigger litter bins are also being installed on the Slipway Car Park together with a special bin in which disposable BBQs can be safely placed, after use. We hope our visitors will think carefully before using these BBQs on the beach. Many thanks to those hut owners who have been picking up litter left behind by the increased number of visitors

I have been reassured that the placing of the buoys marking the powered watercraft exclusion zone is imminent. I know from previous years that it is a protracted process.
